As required by Missouri statutes and the contracts between Saint Louis University (SLU) and cursponsored charters chools, SLU establishes for each of its sponsored schools what the Missouri Department of Hementary and Secondary Fiducation (DHS) refers to as a "Renformance Contract." The Renformance Contract is an explicit statement of the specific academic, financial, and organizational performance standards SLU has established and uses to an unity evaluate the charter:

SUs and evaluation of a charter school shall be based primarily - though not exclusively - on the school's achievement of standards established in the governing Performance Contract. Failure to achieve certain Performance Contract standards may result in SU requirements of the school including but not limited to the following

the submission of aschool report to SIU addressing the sources of concerns, as well as school plans for remediation three of; the publication of any surfrequire dreport (as noted above) on the drater's website for public access; as chool contract with an independent, external auditor/consultant approved by SIU; and the completion of an audit of the school's educational, financial, or organizational performance as defined by SIU; specific training for board members, achimistrators, staff, or teachers drages in membership and/or officers of the board of directors

SUs decision to renew a charter with a sponsored school will also be informed by the school's record of a nucl achievement of standards in the governing Renformance Contracts
